MATS University, run by Shri Bhagwan Mahavir Jain Education and Cultural Society, is one of the first Private Universities of Chhattisgarh State established by the Government of Chhattisgarh vide Gazette Notification dated November 3, 2006 Chhattisgarh Private Universities (Establishment & Operation) (Amendment) Act, 2006 (No. 29 of 2006), an Act to amend the Chhattisgarh Private Universities (Establishment & Operation) Act, 2005 (No. 13 of 2005).

It was established as a Center of exceptional learning in the form of a Unitary University to impart Higher Education in the State at par with world-class standards in terms of Teaching Learning Process and Infrastructure, the conditions it fulfills so appropriately. The University established by a Jain Society is recognized as a Jain Minority University. EDUCATION SYSTEM


CHAPTER - 2

GOVERNANCE

MATS University, Raipur is a Statutory University managed professionally and efficiently by different statutory committees that are constituted as per the Chhattisgarh Private Universities (Establishment & Operations Act) and Statutes & Ordinances of the University. Governing Body is the Highest Committee which is followed by Board of Management, Academic Council and various other Committees constituted as per the aforementioned rules and regulations. These Committees meet as per the requirements to form apposite strategies, plan to achieve near & distant goals and take appropriate decisions as per the need. These decisions help to achieve academic excellence.

As per the Statutes of the University, Visitor i.e. Governor of the State of Chattisgarh is head of the University. Chairman of the Sponsoring Body is appointed as Chancellor of the University by the Sponsoring Body after obtaining prior approval from the Visitor. Vice Chancellor is the Academic and Administrative Head of the University. Director General is responsible for external tie ups and collaborations. Chief Finance Officer is responsible for all the financial matters and accounting. Registrar is the Chief Administrative Officer of the University who also heads the Examination Department. Controller of Examination discharges his duties under the subordination of Registrar and assisted by an Assistant Controller of Examination. Deputy Registrar performs the tasks as per the powers delegated to him by the competent authority. The administrative work of the university is divided amongst various sections/units for ease of administration such as academic, admissions, hostels etc. which are headed by the respective Assistant Registrar. The Assistant Registrars are assisted by the respective Administrative Officers and Managers of the particular section/unit. Facilitation & Operations (F&O) division of the university is responsible for overall coordination and management amongst various sections/units - Administration, Academic, Admissions, HR, Hostel and Training & Placement. The F&O division comprises of the Registrar, Deputy Registrar, Assistant Registrar, Administrative Officer and Manager with the Registrar as its head.

- 1. MATS University offers all its courses except M. Phil. in semester pattern. MATS University has adopted a continuous and comprehensive evaluation process, which enables the students to learn and become adept even in the most burdensome subject with ease. CBCS is implemented in all courses wherever applicable.
- 2. MATS University invites visiting faculty to provide special outside classroom training (Outbound Learning), industrial visits and corporate talks.
- 3. Student's involvement in research projects at UG and PG level which is an essential component of their syllabus. Also, it is extremely encouraging and brings relevance in their conceptual and practical knowledge by bridging the gap between theory and its application.
- 4. MATS University encourages its faculty to enhance their competence and update their own knowledge by organizing/participating in conferences/workshops/seminars, and undertaking sponsored research and consultancy projects.
- 5. Visiting Research Professors/Experts provide a platform for a desirable interface of students with visiting scholars and professionals from society, industry, and Government.
- 6. Revision of curriculum on a regular basis with inputs from feedback from stakeholders and subject experts from academics and industries by Board of Studies.

All courses offered by the University are approved by concerned Regulatory Authorities. Spreading over around 40 acres, the main campus of the University in the rural area of village Gullu has a huge constructed area of 5,42,564 square meters, providing all the requisite amenities for a peaceful Center of Higher Education at the heart of the state that is hardest hit in the country by Naxal terror, catering to the need of students aspiring for quality higher education provided in a quality way.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Admission Process:

1. Students can register themself by visiting https://matsuniversity.ac.in and clicking on 'Apply Now' for registration.

- 2. Fill the application form and upload the required documents for eligibility and verification, you shall be issued with a System-generated Unique ID and password which will be required for further communication with the University.
- 3. After the eligibility verification by the University, an offer letter (Conditional/ Unconditional) shall be issued and sent to your registered email id in case of online admission and if it is an offline admission will be handed over to you.
- 4. Initial Payment of 10,000 needs to be made at the time of admission confirmation as prescribed in the offer letter by bank transfer/wire transfer/online payment and submits the receipt along with your System ID to the admission department with the copy of the document attested.
- 5. After the confirmation of the fees received by the University accounts, this is for International students an Acceptance letter (visa letter) and a bonafide letter will be issued which is required to apply for the Student Visa at the nearest Indian Embassy/High Commission in your home country. Kindly read the important information as mentioned in the acceptance letter for your post-arrival requirements.

Admission Rules:

- 1. Applicants in their own interest must read and understand all the information published on the university website www.matsuniversity.ac.in and otherwise published by the University from time to time.
- 2. The eligibility criterion for all programs for international applicants is a minimum of 50% in the qualifying examination and having studied the pre-requisite subjects for admission into the desired program.
- 3. For Admission to Ph.D. Programs, the eligibility criterion for international students is Master's degree in the relevant discipline with 55% marks and fulfilment of any other eligibility criteria prescribed by the University from time to time.
- 4. Issue of offer letter (conditional or unconditional) or any information/guidance/ facilitation provided by the University should not be considered as confirmation of admission or access to any facility of the University.
- 5. The University reserves the right to add, withdraw or change any program or tuition fees at any time, without any notice, the information contained herein or otherwise published or announced by the University, as well as any provision or facility as and if deemed necessary, No responsibility will be accepted by the University for hardship or expenses incurred by the applicant or any person(s) on this account, no matter how they are caused.
- 6. For the purpose of equivalency of the qualifying exam, the qualifications as recognized by AIU shall be considered. For any qualification not recognized by AIU, equivalency proof has to be provided by the applicant from the Indian High Commission/Consulate in their respective country or other concerned statutory body as applicable.

EXAMINATION AND EVALUATION

- 1. MATS University is following CBCS pattern as per the guidelines of UGC since 2015.
- 2. Our University conducts examinations in a Semester Pattern. July to December is one academic session, and examinations are conducted at the end of the session in the month of December. Further, another academic session starts from January to June, and examinations are conducted in the month of June.
- 3. Our Examinations Department is well equipped with modern electronic equipments/gazettes like Computers, Photocopiers, Paper Shredder machines, CCTV cameras etc. We are using 20 Computers, 3 Photocopiers and 01 Paper Shredder machine for efficient and timely working of the examination department.
- 4. We are using a state-of-the-art ERP to process the pre-examination and post-examination work.
- 5. Students can check their fees, attendance, course module, results, marksheets etc., through ERP. One App of ERP is also provided to students so they can assess required information through App also using their Mobile Phones.
- 6. In Mats University, we follow the Centre Evaluation System; in simple words, every faculty has to visit the examination section for evaluation of answer sheets. No answer sheets are issued to faculties for evaluation at home. Evaluation is strictly conducted in the Examination Section under the supervision and guidance of the Controller of Examination.
- 7. Generally, results are declared within 45 days (maximum) after completing of examinations.
- 8. To facilitate and protect students during the COVID period University conducted online examinations using the ERP system.
- 9. After the declaration of Results, students are provided mark sheets with the signature of the Controller of Examinations and Registrar. At the end of the respective course, students are provided degree certificate. MATS provides degree certificate with 15 Security features and uses 200 microns non-tearable paper.






Fig. 5.1 Placement Statistics across various Sectors




Fig. 5.2 Placement Statistics across Organizations

- 3. Organized programs for Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff for making them more skillful in the responsibilities that are handed over to them.
- 4. The University entered an MoU with Board of Apprenticeship Trainee (Western Region, Mumbai) to improve the employability of students pursuing Undergraduate level general degree programme.
- 5. The University entered an MOU with Skyline University College (SUC) Sharjah.
